    - a. New Pumper Truck. New truck is here, and has been out on ten calls, pumped water in training.
    - b. NBCFR Station 2- almost finished, about 95% up and running. New invoices sent out for the upgrade to power and air conditioner. Have to cover the floor,
    - c. and do some painting. After A/c will get Kitchen up and going. Interested in donations from the public to finish the parking and extending road base and new areas.
      - 1 Construction- see above
      - 2 Equipment- got 4 gas detectors, waiting on pump for tanks. In looking at future items, would like to see what has been completed.
      - 3 Station Grand Opening- Parking kind of delaying it.
