VISITATION DRESS CODE FOR VISITORS

- Shirt and shoes are mandatory.
- Halter tops, t-shirts (underwear type), tank tops, fishnet shirts or see-through fabrics are not allowed.
- Shirts and blouses with an open midriff are not allowed.
- Sleeveless shirts and dresses are not allowed for men or women.
- Shorts or cut-offs are not allowed (except for pre-adolescent boys and girls).
- Women and post-adolescent girls may wear dresses, skirts (no shorter than three (3) inches above the middle of the knee while standing), Capri pants (no shorter than three (3) inches below the middle of the knee while standing) or long pants. If a dress, pants or skirt appears to be too short, the Supervisor shall be contacted for a decision.
- Shirts or other articles of clothing with pictures or language that may be considered profane or offensive by current public standards shall not be allowed.
- White shirt and white pants or skirts worn together, are prohibited.
- Hats are allowed, but shall be searched.
- Clothing that is too tight or revealing is prohibited.
- Slacks and pants shall be worn at or above the waist.

Failure to comply with the above dress code may result in termination of visitation privileges.
