

## **Inmate Trust Accounts/Commissary Money**

Burnet County Jail offers three convenient methods to send money to an inmate.

1. Visit our kiosk located in the Burnet County Jail lobby. This machine will be available for use 24 hours a day. The kiosk is similar to an ATM machine; instead of giving money it takes it and deposits it directly into an inmate's account. The kiosk will accept cash and credit/debit cards. A fee is assessed to each deposit.
2. Mail a Money Order or Cashier's Check to the inmate with their name and SO# number to:
