### **Court Appointed Attorney Applications**

- Every person charged with a crime has an absolute right to be represented by counsel
- In cases where INCARCERATION is a potential consequence AND if you are indigent and cannot afford an attorney – you may request that the court appoint an attorney to represent you
- Either a Court Appointed Attorney application was completed for you or you were provided with a copy of one to complete on your own, if the latter – you can submit it to the court of jurisdiction in your case
- Appointment of counsel is based on indigence, as determined by local court rules
