

MAGISTRATE'S ORDER OF EMERGENCY PROTECTION

INFORMATION SHEET

Motions to Modify the Magistrate's Order of Emergency Protection (MOEP) must be made in writing (*standard motion format or by completing the request for modification paperwork located on the Burnet County Government / Magistrate's Homepage*). Motions / Requests must be signed and delivered to the Burnet County Magistrate Court either in person or by email (*listed above*). If delivered in person, the Magistrate Court is located at the Burnet County Jail located at:

The motion / request will NOT be ruled upon immediately.

The requestor must provide facts in support of the motion, such as:

- How the order should be modified
- Explain how a modification will not further jeopardize the protected person
- Miscellaneous information that the court should consider when considering a modification

Only thoroughly prepared motions / requests will be ruled upon. It is possible that the Magistrate Court will not be able to rule on the motion / request by paperwork submission only thusly requiring the court to set a Show Cause hearing that orders all related parties to appear in court for the purposes of providing clarity to the court with regards to the modification request. The Show Cause hearing will be set as expeditiously as possible. If a Show Cause hearing is ordered, all parties will be notified of the date, time and location of the hearing.
